



## **TOURNAMENT INFORMATION MANUAL**

### **General Information**

Quality tournament presentations are one of the many important foundations to the image and identity of Grants Pass Golf Club. Tournament play and presentation should always emphasize a fair and enjoyable experience for all competitors as outlined in the Rules of Golf and the spirit of the game. All members are encouraged to participate in club tournaments and are equally encouraged to provide feedback through committee involvement, comments and feedback. The 2011 Grants Pass Golf Club Tournament Manual and Tournament Calendar has been created with the greatest emphasis towards informing members of event dates, times, formats, policies and general rules.

### **Tournament Promotions & Advertisements**

Tournaments shall be advertised and promoted through the golf pro shop approximately 30-days in advance of the tournament date (except Couples Friday Night Mixers which shall be advertised and promoted 2 weeks in advance). Events will be advertised and promoted through monthly Club Newsletters, Monday Memo, Membership E-blasts and signage around the club.

### **Tournament Sign-Ups & Entry Forms**

Tournament sign-ups will be taken in person or by phone through the golf shop for all tournament calendar events with an entry fee of less than \$50.00 per player. Due to the coordinations involved in presenting each quality event the entry close date posted for each event will be followed as written and can only be amended by the golf pro shop professional staff for the purpose of rounding out partial team(s) at their discretion.

**NOTE:** Under no circumstances will this policy be amended for the Club Championship

Tournaments with an entry fee in excess of \$50 per player will require each player/team to complete the respective tournament entry form and return it to the golf pro shop prior to the entry close date posted. Those tournaments that require a tournament entry are listed below:

- The Rogue Pro-Am
- The Caveman Chapman
- Thorns & Roses
- The SCRAMBLE
- The Cave Country Classic

### **Tournament Cancellations:**

In the event a player is unable to play in an event in which he/she has already signed-up for, the player must contact the golf pro shop to cancel before the entry close date. Participants who “no show” and do not notify the golf shop in advance of the tournament close date will be charged 100% of the applicable tournament entry fee. Refund exceptions (due to emergency) may be made at the discretion of the Director of Golf & Operations.

### **Tournament Eligibility**

Each tournament is open to members and guests as specified in each tournament description. In addition, participants in each event will be limited to amateur players only with a CURRENT USGA certifiable HANDICAP. Those amateur players without a CURRENT USGA certifiable HANDICAP who wish to participate MUST PLAY TO A ZERO (0) HANDICAP.

**NOTE:** Amateur status shall be defined by USGA Rules of Golf. GPGC Tournament Eligibility Rules shall amend and clarify that golf industry professionals who teach golf for compensation and have had no active affiliation with the PGA of America or the LPGA of America shall be allowed (when petitioned in advance) on a case by case basis. Each petition shall be in writing and shall be reviewed by GPGC Tournament Committee and Director of Golf with the final decision resting with the Director of Golf & Operations.

### **Tournament Handicaps**

All tournament participants must have a CURRENT USGA certifiable HANDICAP (traditional league play handicaps do not qualify). Each tournament presented will have its own method for applying handicaps posted in this manual (i.e. 80% handicap applied, etc...). Unless otherwise posted, all events will be played with a maximum handicap limit as provided below from the applicable tee for each player:

- Ladies’: Maximum 18-Hole Handicap 40
- Men’s: Maximum 18-Hole Handicap 36

The Handicap Committee will monitor tournament play for exceptional scores. Play which is considered to be uncharacteristic of the competitor’s handicap will be considered by the committee. If necessary and after consulting with the player(s) in question, the Handicap Committee in coordination with the Director of Golf & Operations may adjust a player’s handicap before or during a tournament round.

### **Tournament Score Posting**

Any tournament scoring administered through GHIN TPP software will automatically be posted to the players GHIN handicap. All tournaments designated with an \* on the Tournament Schedule shall be posted as a “T” (Tournament Score) either by GHIN TPP software or by the Handicap Committee.

### **Tournament Rules**

Members and guests who play in Grants Pass Golf Club tournaments are strongly encouraged to know The Rules of Golf as written by the United States Golf Association. It is the responsibility of each competitor to know and play by the Rules of Golf and GPGC Local Rules as they apply to each format played. To insure consistency from event to event the following “Notice to Competitors” is provided in advance for all GPGC Tournament Play.

## **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

Play is governed by USGA Rules of Golf and Local Rules of Grants Pass Golf Club

**TEES:** Unless otherwise stated, players will play from the following tees assignments

- Men will play from the WHITE Tees
- Senior Men who meet the specified criteria will play from the GOLD Tees
- Ladies will play from the RED Tees.

**FORMAT:** The format of play will be announced with the event promotion, sign-up and presentation.

**PACE OF PLAY:**  
Rule 6-7 Undue Play. A player shall be subject to penalty if he unduly delays play.

**GROUND UNDER REPAIR:**

- (1) Areas defined by white lines.
- (2) French drains, which are exposed trenches, filled with visible rocks or stones.

**RELIEF FOR EMBEDDED BALL (Rule 25-2)**  
Through the green, a ball which is embedded in its own pitch mark in ground, other than sand, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay, but no nearer to the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

**STONES IN BUNKERS:**  
Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)

**STAKED TREES:**  
If lie of ball, stance, and/or area of intended swing is interfered with by the stake attached to a tree, the stake and/or rope is treated as an immovable obstruction.

**WATER HAZARDS:**  
Designated by YELLOW stakes and defined by YELLOW painted lines.  
Lines precede stakes and lines are in the hazards.

**LATERAL WATER HAZARDS:**  
Designated by RED stakes and defined by RED painted lines.  
Lines precede stakes and lines are in the hazards.

**PERMANENT ELEVATED POWER LINES & CABLES:**  
If a ball strikes such a line or cable, the stroke shall be canceled and the ball **MUST** be replayed, without penalty in accordance with Rule 20-5.

**OBSTRUCTIONS:**  
All artificially surfaced and graveled roads and paths, all concrete yardage markers and 150 yard pole sockets are immovable obstructions. Rule 24-2 applies.

#### **FREE RELIEF FROM ALL FLOWER BEDS:**

If a ball comes to rest in a maintained flower bed located on the golf course, the players **MUST** take relief. Free relief is provided as follows:

- Nearest point of full relief that is no closer to the hole.
- Hole #8 – Drop circle provided.

#### **RULES COMMITTEE:**

Unless otherwise stated, the rules committee shall be Matt Reams and Jeff Ott.

#### **BREAKING TIES:**

Unless otherwise stated, ties for prize winning places will be broken by the following criteria:

- Stroke Play – Total back nine hole scores will be compared. If a tie still remains, total last 6 hole scores will be compared. If a tie still remains, total last 3 hole scores will be compared. If a tie still remains, hole by hole scores will be compared beginning with the #1 stroke play hole, then the #2 stroke play hole, etc... until a winner is determined.
- Match Play – The match will continue with a sudden death hole by hole playoff until a winner is determined.

All non-prize winning place ties (for GP Cup Points) will be combined and split.

#### **Notes, Definitions and Comments:**

1. Unless otherwise specified, the 14 club rule (rule 4-4) will be in effect for all GPGC presented events.
2. “Through the Green” is the whole area of the course except:
  - a. The teeing ground and putting green of the hole being played; and
  - b. All hazards on the course.
3. Only USGA approved balls, clubs and equipment may be used. The ball(s) a player uses shall be on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the USGA. This is not the one ball rule.
4. Players may use devices that measure or gauge distance only. However, the use of a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect a player’s play (i.e. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc...) is not permitted regardless of whether such an additional function is used.
5. Cell phones may be used for emergencies and rulings only. Cell phones shall be turned off or turned to vibrate during tournament play.
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> Offense: Warning by the tournament rules committee.
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: 2 Stroke Penalty or Loss of Hole.
  - c. 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: Disqualification
6. Players entering into GPGC Tournaments agree “the rules committee” shall have the final ruling on all matters that come before it.

## **Divisions of Play – 4-Person Team Events**

Team divisions shall be either Men's Division or Mixed Division by the following definition:

- Men's Division: All 4 players must be male and play from the designated men's or senior men's tees (when applicable).
- Mixed Division: Two men and two women only. Ladies must play from the designated ladies tees. Men must play from the designated men's or senior men's tees (when applicable).

*NOTE:* There is no division of play that recognizes three men and one woman or three women and one man unless provided by A-B-C-D equitable draw.

## **Summer Rules**

All tournament play, unless otherwise stated, will be played by "summer rules". This means that players shall play the ball as it lies unless otherwise provided by the rules of golf. The embedded ball rule as stated in the "Notice to Competitors" shall remain in effect at all times.

## **Winter Rules – Preferred Lies – Cleaning Ball**

When conditions are present as deemed by the Tournament Committee only, the committee may present tournament play with Winter Rules – Preferred Lies and/or Cleaning Ball rules as follows:

**Cleaning Ball**, Appendix I, Part B/4b

**Through the green**\* (or a more restrictive area defined, e.g. on the 6<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> holes) a ball may be lifted, cleaned and **replaced** without penalty/

Note: The position of the ball must be marked before it is lifted under this Local Rule – see Rule 20-1.

**Preferred Lies/Winter Rules**, Appendix I, Part B/4c

A ball lying on a "closely mown area" "through the green" (or a more restrictive area defined, e.g. on the 6<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> holes) may be lifted without penalty and cleaned. Before lifting the ball, the player must mark its position. Having lifted the ball, he must place it on a spot within **6"** of and not nearer the *hole* than where it originally lay, that is not in a *hazard* and not on a *putting green*.

A player may place their ball only once. A ball is in play when it has been placed (Rule 20-4). If the ball fails to come to rest on the spot on which it was placed, Rule 20-3d applies. If the ball when placed comes to rest on the spot on which it is placed and it subsequently moves, there is no penalty and the ball must be played as it lies, unless the provisions of any other *Rule* apply.

If the player fails to mark the position of the ball before lifting it or moves the ball in any other manner, such as rolling it with a club, **the player incurs a penalty of one stroke.**

If a player incurs the general penalty for a breach of this Local Rule, no additional penalty under the Local Rule is applied.

**Penalty for Breach of Local Rules:**

**Match Play – Loss of Hole; Stroke Play – Two Strokes**

## **Definitions:**

**Through the green** is the whole area of the course except:

- The teeing ground and putting green of the hole being played; and,
- All hazards on the course

**Closely mown area** means any area of the course, including paths through the rough, cut to fairway height or less.

## **Inclement Weather**

It is our intent to always present GPGC Tournament Play in coordination with favorable weather. Events impacted by inclement weather may be delayed, postponed or cancelled depending on the numerous variables involved. The decision to delay play, postpone and reschedule an event or cancel the entire event shall rest with the Tournament Rules Committee.

## **Prize Fund**

The prize fund payout for each event shall be determined by the rules committee. The criteria for payout consideration (unless otherwise stated in advance) will be to award between 25-35% of the field with net and gross prizes combined (not including KP's or other similar prizes). It should be noted that the division between net and gross prizes are very likely to favor a higher percentage of net prizes than gross prizes and that the actual prize breakdown(s) shall rest with the Director of Golf & Operations.

## **Honey Pot**

A honey pot is an extra but optional prize fund created through voluntary cash entries for most every event. Players/teams who wish to compete in the honey pot must declare and pay before the event begins. The payout for honey pots will be determined after the tournament begins and will be structured to award between 25-35% of the field with net and gross prizes combined. It should be noted that the division between net and gross prizes are very likely to favor a higher percentage of net prizes than gross prizes and that the actual honey pot breakdown(s) shall rest with the Director of Golf & Operations.

## **Player Tee Positions**

Tournament competitions shall be played from the Blue, White, Gold and/or Red tees as posted with each tournament description. In general, Men will play from the WHITE Tees and Ladies will play from the RED Tees. Men electing to play from the GOLD tees (when permitted) shall be governed by the following stipulations:

Men Members:

- Play from the GOLD Tees is intended to recognize the shorter hitting player with a consistent equitable competitive option. Play from the GOLD Tees is not meant to be a strategy in itself that changes from one event to another.
- Before electing to play from the GOLD Tees, research shall show that 12 of the last 20 player scores posted for handicap are from the GOLD Tees.
- Player understands that electing to play from the GOLD Tees in tournament play is also electing to play all remaining tournaments from the GOLD Tees for that ENTIRE CALENDAR YEAR.

- Players electing to play from the GOLD Tees shall have their handicaps adjusted accordingly as directed in the USGA Handicap Manual.
  - Handicap will be adjusted for the course slope and course rating from the GOLD Tees (usually, but not always -2 strokes).
  - Handicap will be further adjusted for the difference in course rating between the applicable tees (-2 strokes from white tees to gold tees)

Men Guests

- Guests may elect to play GPGC Tournaments from the GOLD Tees (when available) at age 70 and above.
- Guests understand that electing to play from the GOLD Tees in tournament play is also electing to play all remaining tournaments from the GOLD Tees for that ENTIRE CALENDAR YEAR.

**Grants Pass Cup**

The Grants Pass Cup is a member “Ryder Cup” style competition played at a different off-site location each year (October date TBD). Teams are made up of 22 members and 2 professional staff members. Members earn GP Cup points throughout the season (season defined below) with the top 22 total point leaders qualifying for the 22 member team positions. Each point qualifying event contributes monies to fund the Grants Pass Cup event with the primary goal to fund 100% of the expense for the top 10 qualifiers and as much expense as possible for the remaining cup participants. Grants Pass Team Captains are determined by the #1 and #2 point leaders at the end of the qualifying season.

The Grants Pass Cup Point Season shall begin on the first day following the Grants Pass Club Championship and shall end with the final results of the Grants Pass Club Championship. The 2011 Tournament Schedule shall show GP Cup Point Events in **Black BOLD** title print with the following gross and net point values:

- **Friday Night Mixer Events** – 12 Total Points Gross & 12 Total Points Net
