

**Grants Pass Golf Club
Green Committee Minutes
June 6, 2011**

Gary Fahl called the meeting to order at 3pm. In attendance were John Delaney, Dee Hushbeck, Dean Garrison, Rex Titus, Terry Soeteber, Denny Curle, and Gary Schaefer.

Denny Curle's comments from the Board included reporting that he had met with Don Myrick regarding projects that the Green Committee had under taken. Issues raised by Don have been resolved as far as the Green Committee is concerned. Denny also suggested that he would be willing to get some Forest green stain and get the porta pottie building stained. The committee thought that was a good idea and approved the project.

John Delaney gave his report--discussed adding sand to the bunkers trying to get them more uniform. He also discussed the process of taking the red plant out of the ponds, because it is getting into the fountains and clogging the up. Two memorial trees are being donated and will be planted on the right side of #12 fairway. The new trees will be about 14feet high when planted. They are evergreen Deodoras. John also reported that one of the part time crew will be assigned the care and weeding of all the flower beds. His assignment will be 8 hours per week.

The Green Committee has been discussing putting out a members survey regarding issues around course conditioning and course improvement. It was decided that each member would draft 3 to 5 possible questions for the survey and they will be discussed at the July meeting.

Monday, June 13th is a member work party. The main project will be the refinishing and painting of all the benches on the golf course. Work begins at 9am.
